The excitement of riding is truly represented by the many registrations forms that have been received to ride from now until the middle of July. Also last week, Walk ON was to have the volunteer orientation sessions to instruct volunteers to safely work with the riders and horses to enable a safe ride for everyone. Not only was there a great number of current volunteers returning for assist the program but there was also a great number of new volunteers scheduled to go through the orientation process as well.

During this time period, the horses are doing fine. The stalls are being cleaned daily and projects around the ranch are slowly being completed. I am also working on the organization and completion of the necessary paper and office work that it takes to manage WALK ON.
